PROJECTS & ACTIVITIES

- Attendance of construction meetings and assistance with County Bridge Project on State Street in Avondale Borough. (Note: loaned type “M” inlet top to keep project moving);
- Install Pre-construction signage, and No Pavement marking signage for Schoolhouse/Bentley paving project;
- Coordination, Inspection of Base Repair, Milling, Fabric Installation, Leveling and Paving of Schoolhouse Road, Bentley Road, Portion of Avondale Road, and Portion of Garden Station Road;
- Provided traffic control assistance during base repair work in intersection of Avondale Road and Schoolhouse Road, and Avondale Road and Garden Station Road;
- Temporary Repair of unknown, abandoned storm pipe found by milling operation;
- Excavate and Stone Schoolhouse Road in area of Middle School Entrance;

- Cleaned stone from road surface washed out from driveway, 116 Paschal Mill Road;
- Removed branches and debris from rights-of-way throughout Township;
- Patch Garden Station Road in area of Auburn Road;
- Repaired edge washouts with RC250/Stone, 2 locations on Rose Hill Road;
- Repaired edge washout with RC250/Stone, Hilton Road;
- Removed stone dumped on Road, Heather Grove;

- Excavate and Install stone in washout and off tracking areas, Garden Station Road and Sullivan Road;
- Temporarily filled around several inlets, Wickerton;
- Regraded driveway from paving work and pave, 18 W. Hunter Creek;
