#### NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Mr. Losito:

As a result of an inspection conducted by the Department of Environmental Protection's Southeast Regional Office, Waste Management Program (DEP) on March 31, 2014, at your property located at 731 State Road, Penn Township, Chester County, DEP has determined that you are in violation of the Solid Waste Management Act, Act of July 7, 1980, P.L. 380, as amended, No. 97, 35 P.S. Sections 6018.101 et seq. (SWMA), the Residual Waste Management Rules and Regulations found at 25 Pa. Code Chapters 287 to 299, and the Clean Streams Law, the Act of June 22, 1937, P.L. 1987, as amended, 35 P.S. Sections 691.1–691.1001 (Clean Streams Law), as follows:

- A. On March 31, 2014, run off from intishroom compost (MC) was observed coming from MC Storage Areas 2 and 3 and flowing down gullies through the field and into the woods. The run off is conveyed by a trail through the woods to a stream. The stream was coffee colored. This stream is an unnamed tributary to Middle Branch White Clay Creek. The failure to use such methods and facilities as are necessary to control leachate, run off, and discharges from residual waste is contrary to Sections 302(a) and (b) of the SWMA.
- B. The Mushroom Farm Environmental Management Plan (MFEMP) for the property at 731 State Road specifies: "BMPs must be in place to ensure that contaminated stormwater is managed so that no discharge occurs to the surface or groundwater." The Best Management Practices (BMPs) implemented at this site are not sufficient to prevent contaminated run off from leaving the property. The failure of Nutra Soils, Inc., to implement BMPs in the management of mushroom waste constitutes a violation of 25 Pa. Code 287,101.

The activities and conditions listed in paragraphs A and B, above, constitute violations of the SWMA under Sections 302(a) and (b); constitute unlawful conduct pursuant to Sections 302(a) and (b) of the SWMA; constitute a public nuisance pursuant to Section 601 of the SWMA; and may subject the offender to civil penalty liability pursuant to Section 605 of the SWMA.

An unpermitted discharge to waters of the Commonwealth constitutes a violation of Sections 301 and 307 of the Clean Streams Law. Such violations also constitute unlawful conduct under Section 611 of the Clean Streams Law and are subject to the enforcement provisions of Section 605 of the Clean Streams Law, which includes the assessment of civil penalties.

You are hereby notified of both the existence of the violations as well as the need to provide prompt correction. Failure to correct the violations may result in legal proceedings under the SWMA. Under the SWMA, each day of the violation is considered a distinct and separate offense and will be handled accordingly.

Within 7 days of receipt of this notice, please submit a plan and a schedule detailing the actions you will take to correct these violations and prevent their recurrence.

This Notice of Violation is neither an order nor any other final action of DEP. It neither imposes nor waives any enforcement action available to DEP under any of its statutes. If DEP determines that an enforcement action is appropriate, you will be notified of the action.

On March 31, 2014, I (Kevin Maskol) investigated a discolored stream in the woods near Hipkins Road in Penn Township, Chester County. Anil Patel, Environmental Engineer, was also present from the Department. An unnamed tributary (UNT) of the Middle Branch White Clay Creek flows east through the wooded area. The small stream was observed as it came out of a culvert. The stream was coffee colored. We followed the creek upstream through the wooded area. The stream became smaller and nearer to the southern edge of the woods as we walked west. Long fingers of dark colored runoff were observed coming down a trail that runs through the woods. This runoff appeared darker and more concentrated as we walked up the trail. We followed the trail to a field where mushroom compost (MC) is being stored.

This field is on a property owned by Mike Losito. The property has a current MFEMP and the MC is managed by Nutra Soils, Inc. MC runoff was observed coming from MC Storage Areas 2 and 3 and flowing down gullies through the field and into the woods. The runoff is conveyed through the woods to the stream by the trail. Page 11 of the MFEMP specifies: "BMPs must be in place to ensure that contaminated stormwater is managed so that no discharge occurs to the surface or ground water." The best management practices implemented at this site are not sufficient to prevent contaminated runoff from leaving the property. The failure to implement best management practices when managing mushroom waste is contrary to 25 Pa. Code 287.101. The failure to use such methods and facilities as are necessary to control leachate, runoff, and discharges from residual waste is contrary to Section 302(b) of The Solid Waste Management Act. An unpermitted discharge to the waters of the Commonwealth is contrary to Sections 301 and 307 of the Clean Streams Law.




Image 06: Runoff from mushroom compost flowing through a gully in the field





Image 08: Runoff from MC Storage Area 3

Image 09: Concentrated runoff from mushroom compost




Image 10: Concentrated runoff from mushroom compost leaving the field and entering the woods
