ORDINANCE NO. 196

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LONDON GROVE, CHESTER
COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AMENDING SECTION 16-101 OF THE CODIFIED
ORDINANCES OF LONDON GROVE TOWNSHIP TO AMEND THE RULES
AND REGULATIONS APPLICABLE TO GODDARD PARK**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of London Grove, Chester County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by its authority as follows:

Section 1. Section 16-101 of the Codified Ordinances of London Grove Township is amended by deleting subsection 12 and 16 to replace with the following:

- 12. Pet owners and handlers are required to clean up after pets anywhere within the park, including in the dog park. All pets must be kept on leashes except dogs within the dog park. Animals must be licensed and immunized. Dogs are not permitted on or within the playground.*

- 16. The following activities may not be undertaken within the park unless written authorization has been obtained from the Township:*
 - The distributing, selling, servicing, or renting of any supplies, equipment, material, commodities; or soliciting for any purpose.*

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. If any sentence, clause, section or part of this ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any other remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections, or parts of this ordinance.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall become effective within five (5) days after enactment.




