AQUA AMERICA PURCHASE**

A RESOLUTION of the London Grove Township in the County of Chester, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, to support Chester Water Authority's Decision to reject Aqua America's offer to purchase.

BE IT RESOLVED AND ENACTED, and it is hereby resolved and enacted by the London Grove Township Board of Supervisors, of the County of Chester, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania:

SECTION 1. We support the unanimous decision of the Board of Directors of the Chester Water Authority (CWA Board) to reject the proposal of Aqua America to purchase Chester Water Authority's (CWA) assets and customers.

SECTION 2. We request the CWA Board not sell its assets or customers to a "for profit" company.

SECTION 3. We request that the CWA Board continues to protect our Township's residents and businesses by putting the interest of the ratepayers first when making decisions about the Authority's operations and future.
