**I. Avon Grove High School Temporary Lighting**

Mr. Scott-Harper called the special meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. He explained that the Board will be holding a special meeting to discuss the temporary lighting at Avon Grove High School as well as the AP District Zoning and then the Board will partake in a work session with the ASHER (Active Shooter/Hostile Event Response) team to discuss preparedness, response and recovery from hostile events in the Township.

Mr. Dennis Pagan, Supervisors of Buildings and Grounds, Avon Grove School District reviewed that the district had a track replacement project scheduled for this summer (2019). After the work began, they ran into some problems and a change order had to be issued which delayed a paving contractor to complete the paving work, which now brings them into the sports season. The alternatives were wait till November, but the weather is not conducive for paving then. Wait till the spring, that is too late for the track season. The alternative that they have come up with is to relocate all of these activities to the turf field, reschedule all games to 4:00 p.m. and only use the temporary lights if absolutely necessary. The expected completion date for the project is September 28, 2019 and we are on track to meet that date.

Mr. Scott-Harper stated that he is glad that the Township and School District were able to come to some sort of resolution on this matter. He also stated that there has been poor communication between the school district and the Township and that needs to change. Mr. Pagan agreed and stated that he is in the process of developing a comprehensive plan to make sure that going forward the communication is there. Mr. Weer, Township Fire Marshal, stated that he appreciates the Boards support with these challenges and that he thinks the Township and the School District are in a good spot moving forward. Ms. Kristine McNicholas, Resident, asked what the time frame on the lighting would be and that the Township notify the residents by putting something on their website and social media account about it. Mr. Scott-Harper explained that the lights are temporary and are only to be used as necessary till September 28, 2019.

**AP Zoning District**

Mr. Scott-Harper announced that approximately two (2) weeks ago the Board had a public meeting with the farmers to discuss the AP Zoning District. At that meeting a discussion took place about changing the 10-acre minimum to the 20-acre minimum. Mr. Scott-Harper stated that it is his opinion that he does not see the benefit in changing the 10-acres to 20-acres. He feels that the Township should revert back to the 10-acres and clean up the ordinance a little. The Board agreed.

**II. Adjournment**

Mr. Szakas made a motion to adjourn the special meeting at 6:18 p.m., seconded by Mr. Zurl and approved by a vote of 5-0.
