1. Call To Order-Meeting called to order at 7:00

4. Approval/Correction of the minutes of October 2020 meeting were approved

5. Park Report

a. Park- Director Kinsey gave a report citing the following: mowing continues due to the mild fall weather, the chain climb for the playhouse has arrived and will be installed shortly, issues still persist with the solar panels so the power for the lights in the gravity fed lavatory are being kept on with a gas powered generator.

6. Old Business

a. Laura discussed the February meeting with the BoS when the PRB is scheduled to present the park goals, concept plan and shelf ready projects. Eric has submitted some slides to the committee for evaluation in regard to the presentation. Audrey suggested creating more slides rather than have them so text heavy. She also said the maintenance costs of the park need to be incorporated into the program. Laura suggested adding some photos from the park to further illustrate the project possibilities. She will be forwarding them to Eric. Shane mentioned that if the coronavirus is still an issue the meeting with the board would be virtual and we would have to plan accordingly. The concept plan map has to be scanned and enlarged for the presentation.

Once the next iteration of the powerpoint is finished it will be sent out to the PRB members, hopefully for the December meeting.

7. New Business

a Website-Can the maps on the website be updated? Would this be something Ron Ragan could do? Shane will contact Ken about this.

b. Trail Connection-There is a possible trail linkage that would connect Rosehill Road and Martin Drive at Inniscrone. It would be a mid-block walking connection that could work since the township owns that east side of Rosehill right near the corner. It would require BoS approval and funding at approximately \$15,000 to \$20,000. It might be a fitting project for a DCNR grant.

c. Eric asked about the possibility of bringing the old West Grove Farmer's Market to London Grove at the park. This will be a multi-prong endeavor to contact the vendors and see if we can provide what they need and whether the township would be in compliance with county health regulations.

d. Laura expressed a desire to more fully realize the trail system and connection issues across the township.

The next meeting of the PRB will be December 16th at 7pm. It will most likely be a hybrid style meeting.
